We apologize for the delay in sending the completion report though the project was executed a month ago due to our Provincial chapter and the summer vacation. Here I would like to give the specific details about the execution of each project.

### 1. Brick Making Project

Mr. Francis (54years) & Mrs. Amutha Francis (48years) family with two children are from Ladapadi Village of Randham Mission. They are in the Brick Making business which is the only source of Income. Francis family are the care takers of the Ladapadi substation, responsible, hard working and a faithful Catholic family. So far the raw material (clay/mud) for the bricks were not restricted and was freely available. With the recent Amendment of the State Law, put the category of Mud/clay in the Mining Department. To get the raw material you need to get a Licence and pay a heavy price to purchase the clay/mud. It has come as a big hurdle for all the villagers especially the family of Mr. Francis & Mrs. Amutha. The Passionists wanted to help them to out to restart their business by providing the financial help for one season of brick making. With the profit from the first season, they will be able to support themselves in the next season. This will help him to pay their debts, educate his children. The amount was distributed and the family is so happy for your great help. And they promised to pray for all you in their daily prayers.
